

Numbering Code for Microchem's Target Formulations

Präfix / Suffix (Letters):

Stands for the Deco Products used and the physical state of the target formulation:

DCL-	Liquid formulation with Decol
DF-	Liquid formulation with Decosoft
DA-	Liquid formulation with Decosilk Art
-P	Powder coating formulation

First Digit:

Stands for the dilution base and the preferred substrates for the formulation:

0 – 4	Solvent borne Coatings
5 – 9	Water borne Coatings
0 or 5	Plastics and Elastomers
1 or 6	Leather, Textiles, Paper and Foils
2 or 7	Wood and Furnitures
3 or 8	Walls, interior and exterior
4 or 9	Other substrates (metal, glass etc.)

Second Digit:

Stands for the number of components:

1	One component formulation
2	Two component formulation

Third and Forth Digit:

Serves as a continuing number for the specific target formulation.

Examples:

DF-5202	Water borne two component target formulation with Decosoft for plastics and elastomers.
DF-0201	Solvent borne two component target formulation with Decosoft for plastics and elastomers. Old target formulation No. DFJ0793.
DA-8102	Water borne one component target formulation with Decosilk Art for wall coatings. Old target formulation No. DAL 532.
DA-P9101	Powder coating target formulation with Decosilk Art for metal coating applications.
